Request for submission of oil reports for the calendar year 2013

The 1992 Fund Convention, to which Malaysia is a Party, requires that all Member States report to the Director of the 1992 Fund by 30 April each year the name and address of any person in that State who is liable to pay contributions to the Fund, as well as the quantity of contributing oil received by each person during the preceding calendar year.

A report should be submitted for each person who received in that State more than 150 000 metric tonnes of contributing oil (crude oil and heavy fuel oil) either after carriage by sea or by other modes of transport (eg by pipeline, non-sea-going barge, road or rail) having previously been received after carriage by sea in a non-Member State. Reports should also be submitted for each person in any group of “associated” persons (ie commonly controlled entities) who together received more than 150 000 tonnes of contributing oil in that year.

A form for reporting receipts of contributing oil is available online at the IOPC Funds’ website (www.iopcfunds.org). The oil report form should be filled out electronically, printed and then signed by both the oil receiving company or entity and the Government authority before it is sent to the IOPC Funds.

Reports for 2013 should be submitted to the IOPC Funds by 30 April 2014.

A list of persons in your country for whom oil reports were submitted for the years 2010 – 2012 and the quantities received by them in each of these years is enclosed, together with a list of the States for which the 1992 Fund Convention was in force on 1 January 2014.

The submission of oil reports is crucial to the functioning of the international compensation regime and the non-submission of oil reports has been repeatedly highlighted as a matter of great concern by the 1992 Fund Assembly.
