THE MERCHANT SHIPPING ORDINANCE, 1952

(No. 70 of 1952)

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 519 of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, the High Commissioner in Council hereby alters the fees prescribed in the Twelfth Schedule to the said Ordinance—

(a) for licensing fishing boats, by substituting for the existing fees the following:

and in addition \$25 in respect of each additional 50 h.p. or part thereof;" and

(b) the fee prescribed for licence books, by substituting the figures "\$1.00" for the figures ".50" appearing against the words "for every cargo fishing or passenger boat."
