THE MERCHANT SHIPPING ORDINANCE, 1952
(No. 70 of 1952)

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 519 of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, the High Commissioner in Council hereby alters, with effect from 1st January, 1954, the fees prescribed in the Twelfth Schedule to the said Ordinance for licensing boats by substituting for the words and figures—

“For every fishing boat 50”
the following:

THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS ORDINANCE, 1948
(F. of M. No. 10 of 1948)

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Emergency Regulations Ordinance, 1948, the High Commissioner hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the **Emergency (Amendment No. 8) Regulations, 1953.**

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 17EA of the Emergency Regulations, 1951, is hereby amended by inserting the words and commas “pliable plastic or synthetic cloth, sheeting or material, including imitations thereof,” after the word and comma “cloth,” which occur therein.
