An Act to amend the Merchant Shipping (Amendment and Extension) Act 1977.

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to—

- (a) amend the long title to, and sections 1(2) and 4 of the Merchant Shipping (Amendment and Extension) Act, 1977;
- (b) introduce new sections 5, 6, and 7 into that Act;
- (c) repeal the Modification of Laws (Merchant Shipping) (Malaysia Registry) Order, 1964;
- (d) repeal provisions of the written laws of the States of Sabah and Sarawak which correspond to the provisions of Part IIA and Part IIB of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952; and
- (e) provide for the provisions of Part IIA and Part IIB of the Ordinance to prevail over any other written law inconsistent therewith or contrary thereto, as it is intended for the time being to extend to those States only Part IIA and Part IIB of the Ordinance as amended.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
