MERCHANT SHIPPING (RADIO) RULES 1959*

[L.N. 15/1959]

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 262 of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, the Minister of Transport hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the **Merchant Shipping (Radio) Rules 1959**.

2. The Merchant Shipping (Radio) Rules, 1952, made by the Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation in the United Kingdom and which under the provisions of section 262 (6) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, apply to all sea-going passenger ships and cargo vessels of over 500 tons gross registered as British and Malayan ships in the Federation of Malaya, and all other sea-going ships while they are within any port in the Federation, are hereby amended by deleting the table appearing in paragraph 3 of the Third Schedule thereto and substituting the following table therefor:
