



**BOAT (FURNISHING OF PHOTOGRAPHS BY  
APPLICANTS FOR LICENCES AND NEW  
OWNERS) RULES 1965\***

[L.N. 17/1965]

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 483 (j) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, the Minister of Transport hereby makes the following Rules:

**1. Citation.**

These Rules may be cited as the **Boat (Furnishing of Photographs by Applicants for Licences and New Owners) Rules 1965.**

**2. Furnishing of photographs.**

(1) Every applicant for a boat licence under Part XIII of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1952, and every new owner of a boat licensed under section 475 of the said Ordinance shall at the time of making the application or as soon as may be after the change of ownership in each case furnish to the Port Officer photographs of the boat and the crew thereof if any.

(2) Photographs furnished under paragraph (1) shall be in duplicate and photographs of the boat shall be in post-card size and photographs of each member of the crew shall be in the normal passport size.

(3) The Director of Marine may exempt any applicant or new owner from the requirement of this Rule. [Ins. P.U. (A)

**3. Photographs in licence book and register.**

The Port Officer after being satisfied that such photographs furnished under the preceding rule are genuine shall affix one of each in the licence book and the others in the register kept and maintained for the purposes of these Rules.

**4. Penalty.**

Any person who fails or neglects to comply with the provision of paragraph (1) of rule 2 of these Rules shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred ringgit.
