INTERIM GUIDELINES ON SAFETY FOR NATURAL GAS-FUELLED ENGINE INSTALLATIONS IN SHIPS

1. The purpose of this Notice is to inform the maritime community of the Interim Guidelines On Safety For Natural Gas-Fuelled Engine Installations In Ships adopted by Maritime Safety Committee on its 86th session on 5th June 2009 ([MSC RESOLUTION 285 \(86\)](#)).
2. These Interim Guidelines have been developed to provide an international standard for ships, other than vessels covered by the IGC Code, with natural gas-fuelled engine installations.
3. The goal of these Interim Guidelines is to provide criteria for the arrangement and
4. Installation of machinery for propulsion and auxiliary purposes, using natural gas as fuel, which will have an equivalent level of integrity in terms of safety, reliability and dependability as that which can be achieved with a new and comparable conventional oil-fuelled main and auxiliary machinery.
5. Malaysia ship owners wish to installed Natural gas fuelled engine are advised to comply with this interim guidelines.
