1. Seksyen 249R(1) Ordinan Perkapalan Saudagar 1952, memerlukan syarikat (pegawai sekuriti syarikat), nakhoda (pegawai sekuriti kapal), pegawai sekuriti kawasan pelabuhan, pegawai sekuriti kemudahan pelabuhan yang dilantik perlu melaporkan dengan kadar segera mengikut prosedur yang dinyatakan kepada Pihak Berkuasa Yang Di Lantik (PUSKOM) apabila berlakunya insiden sekuriti seperti berikut:

a) letupan yang bukan disebabkan oleh satu kemalangan;

b) ancaman bom, serangan bersenjata, penahanan tebusan, penumpang tanpa izin atau rampasan; atau

c) sebarang pencerobohan sekuriti (seperti perkara 15.11 bahagian B kod ISPS).

1. Section 249R(1) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance 1952, requires that the company (CSO), master of a ship (SSO), Maritime Transport Security Officer (MTSO), operator of designated marine facility (MFSO) shall report immediately in accordance with the prescribed procedures to the Designated Authority (MMCC) upon the occurrence of the following security incidents:

a) an explosion that is not the result of an accident;

b) a bomb threat, armed attack, hostage taking, stowaway or hijacking; or

c) any breach of security (as per item 15.11 part B of the ISPS code).
