APPROVAL OF OIL FILTERING EQUIPMENT

Oil filtering Equipments installed on Malaysian Ships for compliance to regulation 14 of International Convention for Prevention of Pollution from ships 73/78 (Marpol Annex I) shall be tested and approved to the specification recommended by International Maritime Organization.

Oil filtering Equipments and arrangement shall be evaluated, tested and approved by Recognized Organizations acting on-behalf of Malaysian Government not inferior to recommendation adopted by IMO are as listed below:

I Installation of Equipment

- A. For oil content meters as part of discharge monitoring and control systems installed on oil tankers built on or after 2 October 1986

- B. For oil content meters as part of discharge monitoring and control systems installed on oil tankers built on or after 1 January 2005
