PEMAKLUMAN PERLANTIKAN JABATAN LAUT MALAYSIA (JLM) SEBAGAI ‘COMPETENT AUTHORITY’ DI BAWAH KONVENSYEN ANTARABANGSA *INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA 74/78 (SOLAS)*.

APPOINTMENT OF MARINE DEPARTMENT OF MALAYSIA (MMD) AS COMPETENT AUTHORITY AS PER INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA 74/78 (SOLAS)

Tujuan

Purpose

1. Notis ini adalah untuk memaklumkan kepada semua yang berkaitan bahawa Jabatan Laut Malaysia (JLM) dilantik sebagai “Competent Authority” di bawah Regulation V/12 of International Convention on the Safety of Life at Sea 74/78 (SOLAS) dan dengan demikian mempunyai kuasa sepertimana yang diperuntukkan oleh Regulation V/12 tersebut bagi maksud pelaksanaannya di Malaysia.
2. Rujukan kepada *Regulation V/12 of SOLAS* menyatakan tanggungjawab dan peranan JLM sebagai “Competent Authority” (CA) berkenaan penyeliaan perkara berkenaan *Vessel Traffic Services (VTS)* sepertimana berikut:
 1. *VTS contribute to safety of life at sea, safety and efficiency of navigation and protection of the marine environment, adjacent*

1. This Notice serves to inform all relevant parties that Malaysia Marine Department (MMD) have been appointed as Competent Authority as per Regulation V/12 of International Convention on the Safety of Life at Sea 74/78 (SOLAS) and therefore has the power as intended by Regulation V/12 for the purpose of implementation in Malaysia.
2. Reference to Regulation V/12 of SOLAS states MMD's responsibilities and role as the "Competent Authority" (CA) regarding the supervision of Vessel Traffic Services (VTS) matters as follows: -
 1. *VTS contribute to safety of life at sea, safety and efficiency of navigation and protection of the marine environment, adjacent*

shore areas, work sites and offshore installations from possible adverse effects of maritime traffic.

2. *Contracting governments may establish VTS when, in their opinion, the volume of traffic or the degree of risk justifies such services.*
 3. *Contracting governments planning and implementing VTS shall, wherever possible, follow the guidelines developed by the IMO.*
3. JLM sebagai “Competent Authority” (CA) akan mengambilkira garis panduan yang digunapakai di peringkat antarabangsa seperti rujukan kepada dokumen *IMO Assembly Resolution A.1158(32) Guidelines for Vessel Traffic Services recommends that contracting governments take into account the guidelines when planning and implementing VTS in accordance with regulation V/12 of SOLAS.*
